II. Eligibility

- 1. Students aged between 16-27 (born between 1998.01.01-2009.12.31) who currently study in Hungary.
- 2. Neither the contestant nor his/her parents are Chinese citizens.
- 3. Those who ranked among top six in the grand finals of previous Belt and Road Youth English-Speaking Competition cannot participate again.

III. Schedule (subject to change)

Venue: Lecture Room 5, Rector's building (Hungary, Szeged, Dugonics ter 13, 6720)

Time: 16:30-18:30 June 4th Wednesday, 2025

IV. Competition Rules

- 1. The competition consists of the following two parts, with a total of 5 minutes speaking time for each contestant.
 - A. Prepared speech (3 minutes): The contestant delivers a prepared speech on the given topic: "As global citizens in the digital age, how can we overcome bias as we build a connected world?" (Click to see background info video).
 - B. Impromptu speech(2 minutes): The contestant draws from a set of topics and speaks on the chosen one after 10 minutes' preparation.
- 2. No text materials or props should be used/brought to the stage; Penalty shall apply if this happens.
- 3. The speeches shall be assessed in terms of content (50%), language (30%) and overall impression (20%).

V. Awards

- 1. The competition will elect one champion, two first prize winners, three second prize winners, four third prize winners, and up to five merit award winners.
- 2. All contestants and coaches will receive certificates issued by the organizing committee. There should be no more than two coaches per contestant.
- 3. The champion will be awarded international travel to China for the global semi-final and the cultural tour program in China scheduled for October, 2025.

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VI. Registration

- 1. To registrate, please send the **Registration Form s**(Excel) **and your prepared speech script** to **konfuciusz@szte.hu**, no later than **17:00**, **May 20 Tuesday**, **2025** (Hungarian time). For the subject of your email and the filename of your script, please use: BRESC family name first name.
- 2. A prelimary selection will be conducted to determine the top 15 candidates for the Hungary qualifying competition. An email notification will be sent to those elected.
- 3. Registration indicates acceptance of the following terms and conditions which includes important information on the competition:
 - A. Declaration: Contestants should ensure the authenticity of their personal information and the originality of their works. Falsified information or plagiarization will disqualify the contestant.
 - B. Copyright: All rights reserved. The copyright of speeches, photos, audio, and video recordings during the competition belongs to 21st Century English Education Media and Confucius Institute at the University of Szeged.
 - C. The 21st Century English Education Media & Confucius Institute at the University of Szeged holds the final right of explanation.
